



As part of our plan for the growth and development of our school and to continue striving to make a Catholic education available to all students, St Joseph School is beginning the initial phases of enrollment for the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP). This program allows qualifying students to receive a voucher to cover tuition costs at a school of their choice.

The structure of the program requires St Joseph School to identify the number of classroom seats that we will open for WPCP students. Therefore, to determine the number of seats to open for the 2018-2019 school year we are researching the number of students currently enrolled in our school who may qualify. Qualifying students meet the income requirements below and are either transfer students from outside St Joseph School in grades 1-8, or current St Joseph School students entering 4K, kindergarten (5K), or 1st Grade.

Please look at “Table 2” above to determine whether your family qualifies based on the 2018-2019 income limits. Your “Maximum Yearly Income” is determined by the Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) on the federal income tax return for the prior calendar year (2017 for the 2018-2019 school year). Family income includes the income of the student’s parent(s)/legal guardian(s) that reside in the same household as the student applicant. Furthermore, if the student’s parents/legal guardians that reside in the same household are married, their income is reduced by \$7,000 when determining income eligibility.
